

## New Trash and Recycle beginning August 1, 2022

We are thrilled to be your new waste and recycling provider. Effective August 1, 2022.

#### **New Carts:**

Beginning on July 21, new Rhino Removal Trash and Recycle Carts will be delivered. We will deliver the same number of carts currently registered to your address. Waste Connections will collect/remove their carts beginning July 25. Rhino Removal will not service any Waste Connection carts. Please discontinue to use your Waste Connection Trash and Recycle cart after Friday July 29. Rhino Removal cannot empty any Waste Connections carts.

Residential Rates: Trash and recycle once weekly. Bulk on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of 4<sup>th</sup> collections each month.

Trash Rate: \$18.33 per month Extra Trash Carts: \$7.94 per month Extra Recycle Cart: \$5.75 per month

Senior Citizen 65+ Years: \$17.23 per month

#### Service Day:

- Winn Ridge Monday
- Sandbrock Ranch Tuesday
- Aubrey City Limits East of Railroad Tracks Wednesday
- Silverado and Aspen Meadows Thursday
- Aubrey City Limits West of Railroad Tracks Friday

### **Observed Holidays:**

If any of the following holidays fall on a collection day service will **shift forward by one day**.

- New Year's Day
- Independence Day
- Thanksgiving
- Christmas

Trash/Recycle/Bulk: Everything is collected on your service day and must be out by 7:00am.

**Trash** – All wet kitchen/bathroom trash must be bagged and placed inside of your trash cart with the lid completely closed. Trash must be set-out by the curb **no later than 7:00am.** 

**Recycle – Collected weekly on your service day.** Place only clean approved items inside your cart with the lid closed. Please visit www.RhinoRemoval.com and click Communities/Aubrey/Recycle Guidelines.

Bulk, Extra Trash, and Limbs – Collected on your 2nd and 4th service day each month.

Bulk is waste items not generated on a normal basis. All wet kitchen trash must be in trash cart, not on the ground for bulk pick.

Up to four (4) yards of bulk, extra trash, limbs, and brush collected on your 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> collection days each month.

Bulk items include furniture, mattresses (must be bagged, which can be purchased at a grocery store), appliances (A/C units, refrigerators, and freezers must have freon removed by a licensed professional and appliance must be tagged), carpet (follow same guidelines as those for limbs/brush), hot-water heaters, and fence panels. Fence panels must be cut into 4'x4' sections.

Limbs/brush must be in clear individual piles measuring not more than 3'x3'x3' and 50 pounds or less AND bundled and tied.

Heavy Bulk: Bulk items that are too heavy or awkward in shape for a single crewmember to safely load into truck. These items include: armoire, entertainment center, couch, king/queen mattress/washer or dryer/refrigerators/bags or boxes over 50 pounds. Call 469-607-4466 to schedule a heavy bulk pickup.

No loose wood. Wood/lumber must be bundled and tied together not more than 4 feet in length weighing 50 pounds or less.

**Prohibited Items:** Never place any of these items in your carts. They can cause our trash trucks to catch on fire.

No Batteries, Paint, Gasoline/Kerosene, Motor Oil, Automotive Fluids, Pool Chlorine, Fertilizer, Pesticides, Herbicides, Bleach, Household Cleaning Products, Medical Waste, Radioactive Material, Radioactive Medical Waste, Tires, Gun Powder, Bullets, Explosives, Fireworks, or Cooking Oil.

**Other Prohibited Items:** Please do not place any of these items in your cart. They can cause damage to our trucks.

Dirt, Rocks, Bricks, Tile, Shingles, Concrete, or any material generated by a contractor including construction, remodeling, or landscaping.

Acceptable Recycle Items: Keep it very simple and basic. If you are not sure if it can be recycled, most likely it cannot. Acceptable items: clean cardboard, paper, plastics 1 and 2 which are water bottles, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, etc...., glass bottles, and steel and tin cans.

Unacceptable Recycle Items: Styrofoam, wood, grass, dirt, appliances/electronics, clothes, shoes, extension cords, and trash.
